Lanzarote Hits A Record High

Tourists have been arriving for winter and spring vacations to Lanzarote for quite some time now. The latest data put together by the Spanish Meteorological Agency have established that Lanzarote, along with the other Canary Islands, have experienced their hottest winter since 1961. For people who have already arranged a break though, the great spell of weather will undoubtedly give you something to look forward to.

The three months from December to February saw the average daytime temperature recorded as 19.4° C in coastal areas across all of the islands. Which constitutes an increase of at least 1°C in comparison with previous winters between 1971-2000. With winter temperatures such as these its hardly surprising that Lanzarote is frequently labelled as a holiday hot-spot

This is not exactly news to many of the thousands of visitors who regularly come to the island in search of the sun. But the island doesn't just enjoy good weather as it also has an great selection of tourist accommodation on offer.

Many visitors to the island now prefer to organize [Lanzarote holiday villas](#) as these offer a high standard of accommodation, with many home comforts. Although as most villas in Lanzarote enjoy the luxury of a private pools and guests often hard to drag themselves away from their pool side. But if you do find all that sunbathing a little tedious Lanzarote offers up plenty of thing to see.

As small island's go, Lanzarote has a higher than average number of tourist attractions, with several dedicated to documenting the history and culture of locals. But it is also an extremely popular location for sports enthusiasts, with any number of activities on offer to tourists, from surfing to golf.
