What Weather to Expect in Torrevieja Spain

The weather in the town of Torrevieja is usually very reliable and the main reason so many tourists come to this part of Spain. Torrevieja is the most popular of the Costa Blanca coastal tourist resorts ahead of Alicante and Torrevieja. Let's take a look at the many reasons to visit Torrevieja.

Basically Torrevieja is blessed because it has a very long summer, albeit humid at times but with nice cooling summer breezes to make it bearable.

Below we list some of the highlights you simply must do when visiting Torrevieja. You can fly into Alicante airport as Torrevieja does not have its own airport and arrange the short transfer over to Torrevieja.

Try a trip to Cartagena which has a long history with the Phoenician, Roman and Moorish civilisations all passing through.

In contrast to high-rise Torrevieja, charming Altea is to the north and rated as the prettiest town on the Costa Blanca. Torrevieja has the two main beaches but there is a lot more to do than lie on the beach all day.

There is a theme park close by in the major city of Murcia as well as the Aquopolis water park outside Torrevieja. The most popular theme park for tourists in this region is the Terra Mitica park a mix of thrill-rides for teenagers and adults and replica rides on a smaller scale for kids. Terra Natura is related to Terra Mitica so you may be able to get discounted tickets if visiting both.

Terra Natura is a fun day out for the kids especially, with a number of different animals to be seen. Aqua Natura is next to Terra Natura and is a separate park being a water park with flumes and slides and pools. Some of the rides are strictly for adults only and this is a much smaller water park than Aqualandia.

In Benidorm itself there are two more parks to be enjoyed in the sun which are right next door to each other. Mundomar is Spain's answer to Florida's famous SeaWorld and Aqualandia is a fantastic water park. There are plenty of bars and restaurants at the parks so you don't need to take your own food. These two parks are only open in high season and can be enjoyed mainly in the summer months.

Even in winter people come to Torrevieja because it is always going to be warmer than Northern Europe. You would have to be unlucky to have a week here where it just rained, still there is plenty of keep you entertained if that does happen.

Torrevieja is famous for its nightlife including comedians, shows, bands and dancing. There are thousands of rooms to stay in be it luxury hotels or cheap apartments. To conclude, Torrevieja is a good Spanish resort, with a good climate and if you like a noisy, busy holiday you will love it here.
