Winter wedding ideas

What could be more romantic than a wedding in the winter? Wedding Attire

The bride could opt for a long white wedding gown and a warm fur cape or bolero, bridesmaids too can wear fur capes and mitts to keep their hands warm. Don't forget to put your tights on. The groom could wear a traditional morning suit.

The traditional colours for a winter wedding are white, silver and blue, why not add a splash of colour with vibrant **bridesmaid dresses**, decorations and flowers.

Wedding Flower Arrangements

This season witnesses the arrival of lots of beautiful flowers for your [winter wedding](#). Eucalyptus, Ivy, Avalanche Rose, Paper Whites, Vanda Orchids, Poinsettias and Holly Berries.

Dress your venue with mistletoe hung from arches and doorways, Use seasonal berries, fir cones and mistletoe in your bridal bouquet and flower arrangements. The groom can wear a Christmas rose or vanda orchid button-hole, or he could opt for a vibrant gerber to create a statement and to inject colour. The Ushers could wear a button hole of berries and evergreen. Mother of the bride can be seen wearing a beautiful wrist corsage of metalina rose, or alternatively have her handbag dressed with seasonal flowers. The Flower girl can carry a filigree handbag dressed with white magic vanda orchids and bay leaves, alternatively she could scatter faux snow. Dress the church pews with seasonal flowers which can then be transferred to your chair covers at your wedding venue.

Wedding Stationery Ideas

Send out an alternative snow globe wedding invite, the paper insert displaying your wedding details Send snowflake invites to your guests or if your wedding is around Christmas time send Christmas cracker invites.

Wedding Decorations and Favours

Use white linen table cloths with scented winter candles and tea lights scattered around the room, decorate the top table with fairy lights and dramatic candelabras, Place goldfish bowls on each table filled with roses, orchids and callas, scatter snowflake confetti and table gems. Use fir cones as place settings, attach a luggage tag with guests name. Alternatively use personalised snow globes as your guests place cards. To compliment the winter theme, name each of your tables, Mistletoe, Chestnut, Holly. Display your seating plan on a wreath and use miniature boxes of mince pies, organza bags of chocolate coins or a

personalised Christmas bauble as your **wedding favours**. Dot lanterns inside and outside your venue to create a romantic feel, consider having a dusk candlelit ceremony, this would be truly romantic?
